## PUBLIC ENGAGES MORE IN CIVIC ACTIONS

### Communication

- Communication Strategy produced.
- Website (www.civicspace.eu) in English, Turkish and Greek. Almost 43.378 views, 17,979 visitors and 10,191 unique visitors since October 2021.
- Extensive use of social media channels
   (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Linked In,
   YouTube, Telegram) to make the EU's support
   for civil society, the diversity and benefits of
   Cypriot civil society more visible.
- 58 Grow Civic articles and action outputs showcased on website to show the diversity and achievements of Cypriot activism and EU support.
- More than 31 newsletters accessed to 871 subscribers.
- 15 videos/films to promote Grow Civic.

### **Database & Library**

- A database containing 266 CSOs' contact information and field of work for networking/ partnering shows the civil society's diversity in Cyprus.
- A digital library with 315 resources to make available local and international documentation related to civil society.

#### Consultation & Outreach

- 21 digital surveys to consult the potential project beneficiaries before starting an activity or collecting feedback/assessment on a completed activity.
- Civic Space's capacity-building and networking events have gathered 690 participants, among who 317 different persons and 150 various CSOs.
- Info-sessions in Lefka/Lefke, Morphou, Iskele/Trikomo, Limassol, Paphos.







# CSOS' CIVIC ENGAGEMENT & ROLE IN DECISION-MAKING ARE REINFORCED

### Help Desk

- 522 tailor-made help desk support provided to more than 81 CSOs & activists on capacity-building topics that took about 716 hours (89.5 days).
- 340 of the HD sessions were for CS VII and VIII CfPs, lasting about 426 hours (54 days).
- 9 out of the 12 Civic Space recipients were awarded with grants.

### **Trainings & Mentoring & Thematic Support**

- 5 mainstreaming guidelines produced:
   Accessibility, Ecology, Gender,
   Rights-Based Approach and Youth. 4
   workshops held to introduce them.
- 30 trained mentors in the pool.
   Ongoing supervision and skillsbuilding support. 9 CSOs benefiting from mentoring.
- 3 Exchange Initiative partnership of 6
   CSOs supported with mentoring.
- 9 capacity-building trainings held followed by coaching support.
- 22 trainers' training skills improved.
- 3 thematic working groups enabling environment, environment and youth supported with technical help desk.

# CSOS' CIVIC ENGAGEMENT & ROLE IN DECISION-MAKING ARE REINFORCED

### **Grow Civic Programme (ACM)**

 74 support requests received, 23 of them approved. 5 actions completed. 4 actions under eligibility check.



- Approved actions' budget total is about 101,887
   EUR (61% of the total); budget of those under eligibility check is 17,800 EUR.
- 56 request owners: 35 CSOs and 21 activists.
- Requesters' regions are: Nicosia (55%),
   Famagusta (16%) Kyrenia and Lefka (9%)
- Top 3 thematic fields of request owners: nature an environment, peace and reconciliation and human rights.
- Top 3 thematic topics of approved actions: nature and environment (26 %), health (22 %) and peace and reconciliation (18 %).
- Origin of support owners: Nicosia (16), Trikomo
   (2), Kyrenia (3), Famagusta (1), and Lefka (1).
- A local call was organised to reach out to rural areas, 10 requests received, 5 found eligible with pre-condition & 3 supported.
- 72 % of the request owners were newcomers and did not receive prior funding from EU or Grow Civic.
- At least **668 Grow Civic help desk** provided at all stages for about **585 hours** (**73 days**).
- 192 request owners received help desk: 111
   CSOs and 81 activists. 68 % of them were new comers with no experience of EU grants or Grow Civic support.
- MIS system and Toolkit of guidelines to facilitate request and implementation







### A MORE ENABLING ENVIRONMENT FOR CSOS' ACTIONS PROMOTED

- Support to drafting and finalisation of the multi-annual strategy to support civil society development in the Turkish Cypriot community.
- Assessment of the civil society environment in the Turkish Cypriot community (2022)
- Joint working group with the Turkish Cypriot local bodies and CSOs initiated and followed to improve the enabling environment for CSOs.
- Workshops to local bodies and CSOs on freedom of association and participation in decision-making.
- Currently, 2 guidelines for implementing the legal text on associations are under production, one for 'district officers' and one for CSOs.
- Standards for participation to decision-making are produced and published.

### GREATER LINKS WITH CSOS IN THE GREEK CYPRIOT COMMUNITY ENCOURAGED



- 54 help desk sessions for intercommunal networking and partnership
- 11 requests made by intercommunal partnerships; 13 requests aimed directly at peace and reconciliation, while 6 others indirectly.
- 5 Grow Civic supported actions implemented in intercommunal partnership. The topics are peace and reconciliation, human rights, environment, health.
- 5 supported actions that aimed at EU MS and IPA level partnership and networking. The topics are human rights, peace and reconciliation, health and disabilities.
- Exchange Initiative with 6 CSOs (3TC and 3 GC) for 5 months
- English translation provided to maximum events and trainings for intercultural participation
- 3 Greek Cypriot mentors in the mentors' pool
- 1 multicommunal CSO receiving mentoring support
- Environment multicommunal networking group supported by held desk
